1. Introduction

The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting.

2. Apologies.

Apologies for absence were submitted on behalf of Councillors A Ashton and F Wilson.

7. Matters Arising

a) Play area - Cllr Joe Briggs and Cllr J David updated the Councillors about the findings from the post inspection carried out by Morral Play Services.

b) Neighbourhood plan update

Cllr C Wheeler updated the Councillors regarding:

- The results from the Neighbourhood Plan Survey.
- Discussions that had taken place with Cheshire East Officers regarding the green open space element.
- Explained the process for finalising the Neighbourhood Plan which included a Strategic Impact Assessment.
- The importance of resident feedback to the draft Neighbourhood Plan.

Councillor Rob Perry (Chair) read out email correspondence on behalf of a resident who was unable to attend the meeting. The correspondence highlighted their feedback regarding the draft Neighbourhood Plan.

c) Roadside Car Parking

Councillors discussed concerns raised by a resident regarding the roadside car parking along the lane at Gauntons Bank. It was highlighted that a hedge row near to the bungalows required cutting back due to the risk of residents stepping straight out onto the road.

Action: Clerk to write to Cheshire East Council regarding the issues raised.

d) Signage - private land (rural speed prevention).

Councillors discussed the purchase of signs that could be a deterrent to speeding. It was confirmed that:

- The signage had to be positioned on private land
- The signage was for information purposes and they would not cause any distraction to drivers.
- The cost for the signage was £15.
- Land owners' permission was required.

Councillor M Turnbull proposed that four of the signs be purchased and Councillor J Makin seconded it.

e) Cemetery Update

- Councillor P Shakeshaft provided Councillors with an update regarding WhichChurch Town Council's proposal to disband the "Cemetery Committee".
- The Clerk assured Councillors that she had written to the temporary Locum Clerk at WhichChurch Town Council regarding the concerns of their plans for disbansion.
- f) Rural Speed limits There was no update.
- g) Update to the Defibrillator purchase for Wirswall

- Councillors enquired about a first aid training course for residents.
